Hostel Policy

Hostel Selection Criterion

- 1. Pursuant to Section 2.13 of By-Laws No. 03 of 2022 relating to Student Residence and Discipline, and in accordance with subsequent decisions made by the Council, hostel facilities will only be provided for students in their first year, fourth year, and final year of the study program, except for those who have been granted special permission.
- 2. One percent of the total accommodation capacity in hostels may be allocated to students falling under the following categories, upon special permission granted by the Vice-Chancellor based on the recommendation of the Hostel Committee:
- Differently abled students
- Students selected for University Sports Teams
- Students with severe medical conditions
- 3. First-year and fourth-year students will be selected for hostels based on the following procedure:
- (a) Applications for hostels are accepted upon a student's enrolment in the University or during the second semester of the third academic year of the program.
- (b) Applications from students residing 60km or more from the Faculty/ Department's location will be considered for the selection process.
- (c) Applications meeting the criteria in (b) will be sorted and listed based on ascending order of annual parental income. The number of students selected will match the capacity available at the allocated hostels for the respective batch.
- 4. The University administration retains full authority to determine the allocation of hostels for each batch of students.
- 5. All students of the Faculty of Indigenous Medicine who are selected for hostel facilities in their fourth year will also be provided with hostel facilities in their final year. Should there be changes in a student's distance from home or annual parental income, the student will be given an opportunity to resubmit a hostel application within three months prior to the commencement of their final academic year in the Degree Programme.
- 6. This criterion will be effective from the Academic Year 2022/2023 of all Faculties

Hostel Fee

The annual hostel fee per student is Rs. 1500/=, and the hostel admission fee per student is Rs. 100/=. The decision of the Finance Committee regarding the fine for not paying hostel fees on time will remain unchanged.
